


# Brunei Coffee Trail

A guide to cafes around the famous landmarks  
in Bandar Seri Begawan and beyond.



# Time for Coffee,

Brunei Darussalam has seen a rise in speciality coffee shops in recent years, particularly in the capital Bandar Seri Begawan, where the coffee scene has grown from a sleepy handful of cafes and roasters to a lively community of coffee shops serving gourmet coffees to the growing local coffee enthusiasts and travellers to this sunny sultanate.

Cafes serving speciality coffees offer a whole other experience from the beloved old-school coffee shops, affectionately called *kopitiam*, that serve a strong coffee brewed from Asian-grown beans steeped in hot water and poured through a coffee sock to get a concentrated coffee base used to make milky beverages sweetened with condensed milk or evaporated milk and sugar.

These traditional shops are still popular with the seniors and baby-boomers: they are lively, bustling and often loud with conversations and service staff shouting customer orders across the shop floor. A *kopitiam* is usually the best place for a taste of traditional local snacks and simple stir-fried one-dish meals, and a feel of nostalgia.



Whether it was curiosity or a desire to continue to enjoy gourmet coffee in one's home, coffee-brewing became a popular activity in Brunei. For some, this hobby turned into a passionate home enterprise and eventually, blossomed into businesses that could bring their creations and knowledge to the public, birthing a gourmet coffee scene played by both drinkers and makers, and a host of sidekicks who add their talents to this story.





The burgeoning cafe scene in Brunei has grown a community that brings together cafe owners, roasters, certified baristas, coffee-drinkers, purveyors of all-things-coffee-related, as well as bakers and chefs who collaborate to showcase their creativity.

This coffee connection has created a support system that reaches out to small businesses around the country, lending a hand to help them survive and thrive. Cafes in Brunei are increasingly collaborating with popular home bakers and a new wave of restaurants helmed by young chefs to offer a dynamic menu, changing the offerings from time to time to keep things fresh and exciting.

Bruneians are avid travellers. Sojourns across the seas can make the heart yearn for the familiar scenes and tastes to re-live the memories of their trips overseas. Many cafes in Brunei are reminiscent of the cafe owners' experiences abroad.



For travellers, this guide highlights some of the cafes that are located within the vicinity of the famous landmarks in Bandar Seri Begawan and in the main towns of the districts beyond the capital. Others will find it useful to have a list of cafes to try, week after week.



# Bandar Seri Begawan



In the heart of the capital by the Brunei river, there are a few major places of interest that one should not miss: the vast water village on stilts known as Kampong Ayer, the Masjid Omar Ali Saifuddien with its shimmering gold dome, the Taman Mahkota Jubli Emas, also known as the Eco-Corridor Park, and the waterfront. Being a major touristy part of the city, a growing number of cafes have conveniently popped up to serve walking tourists visiting the area and many of these cafes are just a short walk from each other.

## Lanes Microbakery & Coffee

Lanes serves classic coffee favourites and pastries that are the talk of the town. This little cafe, located in a small lane hidden among tall buildings, is worth the search if you're in the mood for some fresh bakes, perfect for taking on-the-go while you stroll around Bandar town. They have a branch in Kual Belait town too, just look for their signature decorative bicycle outside the cafe.

## Rustique by Absolute

Like the name suggests, this cafe feels rustic and industrial, yet it is cozy and homely. The cafe's distinct grey concrete is balanced with wooden furniture, greenery and warm lighting. # Tutong

The halfway point on the journey from Bandar Seri Begawan to the other end of the coastline is Tutong town. There are many nature and indigenous attractions beyond the town but a stop in Tutong town centre and the market is the best way to fuel up and stock up for your exploration of the Tutong countryside. Across from the town is the Pantai Seri Kenangan beach where the road along the coastline is interestingly sandwiched between the beach and the Tutong River.

# Seria



As you drive into the Belait district from Bandar Seri Begawan, your first town stop is Seria, the oil town of historical and economic importance to Brunei. On the beach front, you can see the Billionth Barrel monument, built to celebrate the one billionth barrel of oil produced at an oil field in Seria. Small but quaint, Seria town has a handful of speciality coffee places that has only sprung up in recent years. You can take an easy stroll and check most of them out without breaking a sweat.


## Monkey Bars Company
